From the Desk of Fr. Leo

People are willing to undergo a great deal of trouble and expense in order to have their health restored. They submit willingly to a physician, undergo frequent treatments, take expensive medicines, and in fact anything, if only they can regain physical health even though they be at an advanced, old age. How many are equally concerned with regaining the health of the inner person, which may have been brought low by the poison of sin, paralyzed by evil habits of long standing, or jeopardized by willful carelessness in thoughts and actions? Yet, what is more important when a person stands before his or her God at the gate of eternity, physical health or the integrity of the inner person.

Everything in this weekend's Gospel seems to bring before our eyes the penitent sinner who seeks reconciliation and healing from Christ, the great Sacrament of God's love. Not as if leprosy were necessarily connected with personal sin, but this weekend's Gospel vividly conjures up to the mind the dispositions required of the penitent sinner, aware of his great need of the Savior; the loving and willing action of that same Savior in the sacrament of healing which he instituted for the express purpose of healing a person's inner spirit; and the effects as well as the requirements of the sacrament.

First of all, the leper approaches Jesus in person. This is unusual because lepers were supposed to keep at a distance so as not to contaminate anyone. But see how he approaches close to the Lord, with great confidence and utter simplicity, relying entirely on the help of the One from whom he knew help could come. This is the disposition required of the penitent who seeks to be renewed in spirit. Aware, of this utter need of the Savior, he seeks a personal encounter with him, moved by faith in his saving power, and placing his utter trust in the love of the Savior for him, that he could heal him no matter what wounds infect his spirit, no matter what the number and gravity of his offenses. Though sinful, he will not stay away, but come close to Jesus who became man precisely to be humankind's Savior.


Like the leper who is totally renewed in bodily integrity and can live an entirely new life not admissible for him before, so the repentant sinner, renewed in God's love, walks in the newness of the Christ-life, all his or her actions and motivations taking on a renewed direction. His or her aim is now to be more conformed to the image of Christ, his or her Savior, and that will mean a thorough conversion from sinful ways. Even though the conversion brought about by the reception of penance may not have had to do with serious sin, there is always need of a constant and progressive orientation toward walking with Christ the Way to the Father.

Saint Valentine, officially known as Saint Valentine of Rome, is a third-century Roman saint widely celebrated on February 14 and commonly associated with "courtly love." In 1969, the Roman Catholic Church removed St. Valentine from the General Roman Calendar, because so little is known about him. However, the church still recognizes him as a saint, listing him in the February 14 spot of Roman Martyrology. There are many legends regarding Valentines, the most retold being that secretly married couples so husbands wouldn't have to go to war. This was outlawed by Claudius II who was trying to grow his armies and persecuted Christians.

Indoor Mass!!!

We received an email from the Bishop Barber last weekend giving us the green light to get back in our churches!

"Last night the US Supreme Court ruled that Governor Newsome's executive orders shutting our churches for indoor worship was unconstitutional. I welcome this decision by the Court. They also ruled that capping attendance at 25% and restricting congregational singing was reasonable and permitted.

Therefore, effective immediately, you may (not must) reopen your parish church for indoor worship at 25% of your occupancy, as long as you continue to follow social distancing and wear a face covering. We were in a similar situation last summer with indoor worship, and the protocols we established then are still valid. "

From here on out hopefully we will be back inside, but maintaining a maximum of 60 people at St. Rose (25 at St. Patrick) for now.

Please remember face coverings are required, keep six feet distance at all times and only sit in the open sections/pews. During communion, please follow Fr. Leo's directions, and STAY ON THE MARKINGS IN THE AISLE TO MAINTAIN A SAFE **DISTANCE!!!**
