GUIDELINES FOR RECEPTION OF COMMUNION ST. ROSE OF LIMA -ST. PATRICK

- 1. We will follow the usual time frame we celebrate mass on weekends. After the communion service, no personal prayer devotion allowed for now. Church will be opened only for at least an hour.
 - a. Saturday at 4:30 P.M.
 - b. Sunday at 9:00 A.M.
 - c. Sunday at 11:00 A.M. (Port Costa)
- 2. Wearing mask is strictly enforced.
- 3. Ten (10) people allowed per session. Ushers are asked to assist.
- 4. They will line up in the aisle 6 feet apart. Then exit on the other side not on the side where they originally came.
- 5. A ciborium is placed on a small table in front of the altar table. Before the reception, Father will lead the recitation of the Our Father, then "Behold the Lamb of God.
- 6. Individual persons come up to the table, pick up a host themselves, consume it facing the altar, then put mask back and exit. Usher instruct them to use the other door.
- 7. When the first batch had all exited, another 10 people could come in following the same procedure until everyone had received communion.
- 8. Note: upon entering drop your envelops on the basket, since the collection bag will not be passed this time yet.
- 9. Observe distancing in entering and exiting the door. Don't crowd or come too close to others even member s of your family.
- 10. Doors will open 5 minutes before Communion service. No one allowed prior for private prayers. Please cooperation is expected of everyone.
