

From the Desk of Fr. Leo

Several years ago, a thought-provoking article was published in the "Catholic Exponent" (Youngstown, Ohio) entitled: "Mass Lasted Twelve Hours at Marquette, University." It told how some college students and campus ministers spent a weekend at a retreat house, celebrating the Mass at a meaningful, reflective pace.

Before breakfast, they sang the Opening Song and had the Penitential Rite and Initial Prayer. The Gloria, Scripture Readings, Responses and Homily took place before lunch, which was a simple meal to express solidarity with the hungry of the world.

Following lunch, they spoke of the meaning of grapes and wine, of oil, flour, and water, and then mixed dough into loaves for the oven. While the bread baked, some prepared supper and others rested. Later, the freshly baked bread was offered at the altar, followed by the Eucharistic Prayer, the Our Father and Holy Communion.

After supper, the group prayed the Concluding Prayer, received a blessing and all sang the Recessional Song. The article stated that it may have been the longest Mass in history.

Many of us don't see the Mass as something to get caught up in, but as something to get through. No matter how good the quality of worship, if it extends to over an hour, many worshippers become impatient.

The Advent season, which we begin today and continue until Christmas, is the celebration of patience. During this season of four weeks, we reflect on the long centuries of waiting for the coming of Jesus into the world.

A spirit of patience and a slower pace would be helpful to those of us who rush into most things, including worship. Remember, we serve a God who dwells in eternity, where life is unhurried. We, by contrast, are creatures of another world, born and schooled to keep pace with fleet-footed time. To better know God (and ourselves), we must think of and pray to Him in a calm, unrushed manner. In heaven, all are caught up in the eternal contemplation of divine beauty. Our goal is to somebody become immortalized dwellers of this eternity. For now, we leisurely recall the Lord's coming into our world and try to make Him more present in our lives during the Advent time. "Tis the season to be thoughtful and walk slowly. After all, the Lord did not rush into the First Christmas.


