





## From the Desk of Fr. Leo

This Sunday is the celebration of Wind and Fire. The word "Pentecost", per se, does not adequately describe this celebration. It is simply a Greek word meaning "50<sup>th</sup> day" – that is, the 50<sup>th</sup> day after Easter. On this day however, the apostles and the other first Christians truly got ecstatic about their mission of preaching Jesus, they were all inspired.

The dramatic story of Pentecost is told in the Acts of the Apostles, sometimes called the "Gospel of the Holy Spirit." It tells how God 'put a tiger in the Church's tank," and how she started to move, expand and preach boldly to people everywhere. Some were willing, even anxious to die for Jesus, like young St. Stephen. Some did a complete turnabout with their lives, like St. Paul.

Others found themselves not only able to speak in unknown tongues but to work astonishing miracles. St. Peter cured a crippled man and St. Philip seemed to receive the gift of fleet-footedness, when he ran and overtook a chariot pulled by running horses. He heard the driver reading from Isaiah, and explained to him how this was a prophecy of Jesus. St. Philip baptized the driver in a roadside pond and disappeared, snatched away by the Holy Spirit. He had to be inspired. The leaders were no longer afraid to face the world, for they had the Spirit. They were going out and speaking out.

Like His Death and Resurrection, the descent of the Holy Spirit was also predicted by Jesus. This crowning event of redemption confirmed and sealed the Church's confidence in the person of Jesus and His word.

Pentecostals –any more than baptism is only for Baptists. Although interpreted in various ways, Pentecost is for all Christian believers. To live Pentecost, we need not pray in tongues, hold hands in the air, or punctuate statements with "Amen," and "Praise the Lord." These are praiseworthy if natural and sincere, but to be Pentecostal is to be Spirit-filled.

To speak truthfully is to imitate the spirit of Pentecost. To live sincerely without dominating is to live Pentecost. We share the work of the Spirit when we speak to others of God, reflect Him in our actions and support with encouragement and donations those who sincerely tell of His love and mercy from the pulpit and through media. It's all part of modernizing

the age-old message by making all come alive in the name of Jesus.

This Sunday's Liturgy is meant to move us in the flow of the Spirit and make it hard to sit still. Man alive! There's lots of good news to inspire us and enable others to see and feel the Wind and Fire.


