

From the Desk of Fr. Leo

It was His last trip to Jerusalem and Jesus was openly preparing the Twelve for the momentous events of His last days on earth he predicted that His enemies would "mock Him, spit upon Him, scourge Him and put Him to death and on the third day He would rise again." The Lord now was ready to answer any questions they might have about His tragic plight. At this sensitive moment He was also seeking the tender support of these, His closest friends.

The tense silence was broken by the two brothers, James and John, who showed that they had missed the message of the suffering Messiah and were thinking only of Him as triumphant conqueror. They requested places of honor in His Kingdom to be established – at His immediate right and left. Their abrupt and selfish request must have been discouraging to Jesus, who had placed Himself in the role of a servant but was being asked to grant His disciples positions of honor and dignity: The other ten were likewise horrified at the brashness of James and John. It seems no accident that St. Luke omits this incident from his Gospel and that St. Matthew attributes the inappropriate petition to their mother.

Regardless of what exactly happened and who made the request, one thing is clear. Jesus informed James and John and the other apostles that they would all be called to suffer with Him.

Jesus taught that the Kingdom is different from earthly kingdoms. "Great men exercise authority" in the civic circle, He says, but in the Church the great people are those who serve others. "Whoever wishes to be first among you shall be the slave of all." The only way we can share in Jesus' glory is to first share in His suffering.

Contrary to some modern opinions, pain and suffering are not punishments, nor are honors necessarily gifts of God. We must constantly keep clarifying which standards we follow. Like James and John, we might be insensitive to God's ways by trying to be very important in worldly ways. Do we sometimes chant, "I'm number one," at least secretly? Where do we find the Lord's "number ones?" They're not necessarily sitting in high positions of authority, but they are the hardworking servants of society.
